Weill Cornell Medicine, the Hospital for Special Surgery, the Children's Hospital of Philadelphia, Columbia University, and Duke University provided the academic leadership for these 12 week-long seminars. Multiple courses offered valuable hands-on training, which allowed fellows to enhance their practical skills. In response to the dire situation of the healthcare system in many African countries, we have been offering more fellowships to doctors from Africa.

We are happy to welcome these young and dedicated doctors to the Salzburg program and to see our network growing.

In February 2023, we kicked off this year's OMI satellite symposium series in Tbilisi, Georgia. Dr. Natia Vashakmadze, a very active OMI alumna, brought together 250 doctors for a clinical endocrinology conference. OMI faculty member Dr. Peter Lansberg, a world-renowned lipidologist, shared his expertise with an engaged audience. The conference was organized by the Georgian Association of Endocrinology and Metabolism and supported by the OMI, the Ilia State University, and the Israeli-Georgian Medical Research Clinic "Healthycore". What a great example of local capacity building in healthcare!



Imaging the Future

The OMI gives distinguished alumni the unique opportunity to invite international experts to their home institutions. Pediatrician Dr. Anna Arakelyan is an OMI rising star, striving to improve pediatric health services in Armenia. In March 2023, she organized a satellite symposium in Pediatric Radiology at the Arabkir Medical Center, a leading pediatric hospital in Yerevan. OMI faculty Dr. Erich Sorantin from the Medical University of Graz provided up-to-date knowledge through intriguing lectures and ultrasound workshops. During a hospital visit and round table discussions with local faculty ideas for future research opportunities evolved.



Update from the OMI Observership Program


